### MISSION



We will provide well-coordinated & personalized support to wounded, ill or injured Total Force Airmen, Caregivers, and families. AFW2 will facilitate, monitor, and ensure access of care and resources for the Recovering Airmen and their families.

## CARE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

### RECOVERY CARE COORDINATOR



The Recovery Care Coordinators (RCC) advocate for our Airmen to ensure accessibility and minimize delays and gaps in medical and non-medical services. RCCs are considered the program's "boots on the ground" and advocate for the Recovering Airmen, Caregivers, and their families.

### NON-MEDICAL CARE MANAGERS



Non-Medical Care Managers (NMCM) serve as subject matter experts while Recovering Airmen heal from their injuries or illnesses. NMCMs can help with understanding benefits, entitlements and housing, and provide direct access to personnel program subject matter experts. NMCMs can also assist with transition to veteran status.
